CONCEPT NOTE

National Volunteer Programme has announced Social Internship Programme 2019 this summer for the University students enrolled in their study programme.

About NVP:

National Volunteer Programme was established to be a positive change-agent in society by connecting skilled and compassionate volunteers to beneficiary institutions (NGOs) needing their services. The focus is on sustainable growth of not-for-profit sector in Pakistan. NVP works to promote the socio-economic uplift of institutions devoted for the basic needs of the marginalized and disadvantaged community in our society. NVP team offers Voluntary and Social Internship opportunities announced every year.

What is Social Internship?

NVP Volunteer Intern upon selection would be provided with a position based on his/her interest and career devotion. To be part of Internship a candidate should be proficient in required field and be familiarize with knowledge of computer including MS Office applications.

Purpose of Internship:

The Internship programme aims at providing students with the opportunity to gain practical exposure of working in community service organizations. They get hands-on experience during their summer break from studies. On other end, the partner institutions of NVP also get an opportunity to avail professional assistance by NVP Interns.

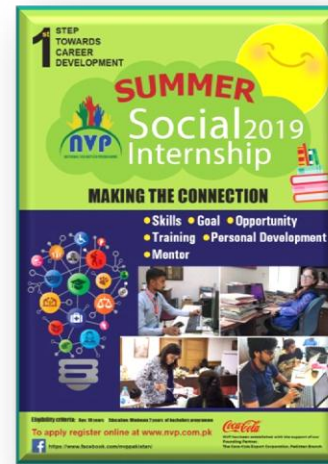
How it Works:

NVP Intern upon selection would be assigned at one of NVP's partner institution. The Intern is assumed to spend minimum of 20 Hours a week and complete their assignment in 6 weeks term. NVP will issue a certificate upon completion of 120 Hours in minimum of 6 weeks (except partner institution has different needs of 150 or 180 hours). Those who qualify would then be invited to an Appreciation session for recognizing them with internship certificate and also to record their feedback.

No. of Spots available:

Positions identified in departments of Social Media, Content/ Report writing, Data Analysis, H.R., Finance, Research, Medical, Designing, Arts work, Event management, Teaching, Graphics, Marketing, Information Technology – falls into following classifications in collaboration with NVP partner institutions.

Eligibility Criteria:

University students who are minimum 18-years, and have completed 2-years of bachelors programme or equivalent are eligible to apply.

Duration of Internship:

1st June to 15th August

Paid or Unpaid:

National Volunteer Programme does not offer any paid activity. We work to promote Volunteerism. All our assignments are available purely on a voluntary basis. This programme serves entirely for the development and socio economic uplift of civil society organizations & charity institutions.

Days & Timings:

Minimum of 120 Hours to be completed in 6 weeks time.

Educational Value:

- Gain hands on exposure of working in a community service organization
- Learn about your career field
- Apply knowledge learned in the classroom
- Opportunity to practice communication and team-work skills
- Open doors to advice on the next step to your career path
- Achieve sense of accomplishment by contributing to a community institution
- Develop and build upon skills like leadership, planning, time-management and project management skills
- Sensitizes new generation about community needs and societal issues.

Application method:

- 1- Register your profile at www.nvp.com.pk as a Volunteer.
- 2- Follow Summer Internship Programme invitation email/ letter and fill Internship link.
- 3- Shortlisted candidates would be invited to Internship orientation session where placement activity will take place.

Registration Fee:

Rs1200. Registration fee can be paid on the date of NVP orientation session. Interns would be entitled for NVP announced internship opportunities for up to 12 months.
